Achievement Related to Academic Goals

Highpoint’s High School made excellent gains towards its End of Year Goals with reading growth meeting targets overall and Math coming very close. Overall, grades 9-11 made a 9% improvement in growth from last year (School Year 2020-2021).

The K8 program made very strong growth at grades K-2 and 6-7 with both gradebands meeting growth goals. Overall math scored much lower with only 6th grade meeting math growth targets.

It is clear additional work needs done to support grades 3-5 and 8 in meeting their growth goals for School Year 2021-2022.
